Since the last report on 12/7/23:

Notable Events:

Williamstown Police hosted our second annual Holiday Gathering, in which over 120 people joined us to celebrate the holiday season with games, food, and more. We were pleased to welcome more people our second year, and hope that next year will see even more community members join the fun.

Williamstown Police Officers assisted the Food Pantry and Wild Oats in delivering Christmas meals to some of our community members.

Through a state grant, Williamstown has been issued an electronic fingerprint scanning machine and has begun the process of getting it setup for use for arrests. This system will allow for immediate transmission of fingerprints to the FBI database following arrests, and is used by many of our fellow Berkshire County agencies.
