Since the last report on 3/7/24:

Notable Events:

Chief Ziemba attended the New England Command College in Chatham Mass instructed by the FBI. This 5-day course requires selection by the FBI to participate and covers best practices and training in policing across several different topics that currently concern law enforcement.

Officer Sigsbury completed training for Sexual Assault Investigator with the Massachusetts Police Training Counsel.

Dispatcher Christy Lemoine was selected as a recipient of the 2024 40 Under Forty awards. These awards are an annual celebration of talented people in the Berkshires, under the age of 40, who have a deep dedication to improving the quality of life for those living and working in our community through their professional work, personal commitment to their community or other efforts to improve the quality of life for those living and working in the Berkshires.

Williamstown Police have actively been searching for Fae Morgana Barbone, a missing person out of the Abington/Hanson MA area. We've been assisted by multiple additional law enforcement agencies for several days in the Berlin Rd area near the New York State border. Our agency as well as our partners have deployed Drones, K-9 Units, Air Wing Units and roughly 60 people on the ground in our search efforts to this point, nothing has been found.
