Since the last report on 5/7/26:

### Notable Events:

Officer Sigsbury spoke for the students at Driver's Education about traffic safety.

Officers Sigsbury and Jennings, along with Dispatcher King, received Save Awards from the Emergency Medical Services Committee of Berkshire County, for their work saving a student through CPR.

Dispatcher Lemoine worked with the vendor ReGroup and Information Officer Christensen to begin the process of changing the town emergency notification system over to a new platform. More info to be published soon.
