Since the last report on 6/4/26:

Notable Events:

Dispatcher Lemoine graduated from the FEMA Basic Academy for Emergency Management, including 168 hours of in-person and online emergency management training.

Officer Sigsbury spoke to Driver's Education students about roadway safety and laws.

Williamstown Police assisted and supported the commencement exercises for Williams College, as well as Alumni Weekend activities.

The Police Department participated in an energy audit of town buildings by an outside company to evaluate places where changes could be made to save energy and money.
