Since the last report on 10/9/25:

Notable Events:

Dispatcher Boyce has officially begun the MPTC Academy as a recruit officer.

Sgt William gave a presentation about safe driving and motor vehicle law for a Driver's Education class.

Williamstown Police staff hosted assessors for the Mass Police Accreditation Commission to begin the evaluation as part of the official process of certification.

K-9 Shelby, Sgt Duprat, and Officer Sacco conducted two K-9 demonstrations and discussions, held at Pine Cobble School and Williamstown Community Preschool.
