Notable Events:

Most of the Williamstown Police staff attended a training session hosted in town for Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training by the Mass Police Training Council. Other area first responders were also invited and present for the 2-day training.

Officer Sigsbury participated in the Williams College Children's Center Touch-a-Truck event.

Williamstown Police and the Town Manager met with Williams College Staff regarding ongoing issues with Off Campus Parties and concerns related to these sites.

Officer Sigsbury and Sergeant William assisted with the Mass State Police Task Force investigation around sex and human trafficking.

Sergeant William assisted with the local Driver's Education program by speaking with students about motor vehicle laws.

Williamstown is pleased to welcome our newest full-time dispatcher, Madeline Swanner.

Sergeant Duprat and Officer Skorupski attended a presentation by the Northern Berkshire Community Coalition regarding their programs and services.

Williamstown Police Staff have begun the process of recertifying for Law Enforcement Dispatch and Crisis Communication as part of continuing education for state 911 requirements.
