Since the last report on 12/4/25:

Notable Events:

Williamstown Police staff attended a presentation on a new computer aided dispatch software to determine if another product would be a better fit for our department and community information.

The new Code Red portal is live, and both the PD and town website are being updated.

Sergeant William assisted with Driver's Education training, speaking about motor vehicle law.

Officers assisted with traffic and safety at the Annual Holiday Walk event.

Chief Ziemba was sworn in as an executive board of the Massachusetts Chiefs of Police Association at a ceremony in Southbridge Massachusetts.

Officer Sacco participated in a training and updates class for Axon body worn cameras.

Officers Sigsbury and Duprea attended training for Acute Stress Adaptive Protocol, to assist as facilitators for first responders following major incidents.
